### **Eligibility and Cost**

Anyone can refer a child to Early Steps. To be enrolled, a child must first be found eligible. Visit [FloridaEarlySteps.com](https://FloridaEarlySteps.com) to review the eligibility criteria.

There is no income or insurance requirement to qualify. Early Steps pays for services not covered by public or private insurance. Insurance is only billed with parent authorization.
