Call to Order – Dr. Ilene Wilkins, Chair

Dr. Ilene Wilkins called the meeting to order, Emily Keeney completed Council member roll call. The presence of a quorum was unable to be established with the members in attendance via phone. The Council was unable to vote to approve the December 8, 2022 Meeting Minutes.

ESSO Upcoming Professional Development Conferences– Liz Gonzalez, MPH, Early Steps Program, Florida Department of Health

Liz Gonzalez informed attendees that ESSO recently participated in public awareness activities, including Developmental Disabilities Day at the Capitol. There are upcoming public awareness events, including Children's Week and the ongoing Public Awareness Campaign. In addition, there are upcoming conferences ESSO staff will attend, including the One Goal Conference and Family Café.

<u>Data System Update</u>– *Dusty Stern, BSN, RN, Chief, Bureau of Early Steps and Newborn Screening, Florida Department of Health*

Dusty Stern shared that the Data System Project continues to move at a swift pace, with staff meeting three times a week for three hours. Two BAs were hired to support the process, and the team continues to work diligently toward launching the new data system.



Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Part C Application – Jessica O. Meyer, MSW, Early Steps Program Administrator, Florida Department of Health

Jessica Meyer informed attendees the Federal Part C Application for the coming fiscal year was released approximately one month ago, and staff members have been working on updating the application. In addition, there are many proposed policy changes this year. Both the Part C Application and the proposed policy changes will be posted for public review on Friday, March 24, and that there will be a public meeting approximately 30 days after that.

Early Steps State Office Program Updates – Jessica O. Meyer, MSW, Early Steps Program Administrator, Florida Department of Health

Jessica Meyer provided an update that ESSO was recently invited to the Pre-K Conference in Orlando, FL, which had a focus on the transition process from IDEA Part C to Part B. Many LESs participated in the conference, including copresenting certain sessions. Jessica Meyer informed attendees that ESSO has developed a partnership with the Family Network for Disabilities, part of the OSEP TA community. Through this partnership, family educational materials are being developed. Additionally, ESSO continues to work on public awareness activities, including developing a HIPAA compliant web referral form, a TA website, and developing short digital videos to help educate and inform families about Early Steps Procedures.

FICCIT Membership Update – Marcy R. Hajdukiewicz, MS, Director, Division of Children's Medical Services

Florida Department of Health

Marcy R. Hajdukiewicz informed the FICCIT attendees that there are no significant membership updates. ESSO is working with the Governor's Office and the Legislative Affairs team to process the applications quickly, and that ESSO will share more once we have an update.
