Position Description:

North Central Early Steps is accepting applications for Florida Licensed Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Speech Therapy Independent (1099) Providers to serve infants and toddlers birth to three years old in Alachua, Columbia, Dixie, Gilchrist, Hamilton, Lafayette, Levy, Marion, Suwannee, and Union Counties. Candidates can choose to serve 1 county or multiple counties. Services are delivered in the child's natural environment and therapists work as a multidisciplinary team member by collaborating with families/caregivers, Service Coordinators, and other professionals to develop and implement the Individual Family Service Plan.

Essential Functions:

- Build rapport with families and team members
- Conduct ongoing assessment of children's development in five developmental domains
- Conduct therapy evaluations and develop Plans of Care
- Assist in the development of functional outcomes and goals on the child's Individualized Family Support Plan (IFSP)
- Communicate with families about their child's development, strengths and needs
- Assist families with embedding functional strategies into their daily routines and activities
- Monitor and adjust strategies to meet the child and family's changing needs
- Participate in collaborative team meetings and consultation relating to the child's outcomes, goals, and IFSP
- Maintain up-to-date files/charts (written and/or electronic) for the purpose of ensuring alignment with specific program requirements
- Assist other personnel as may be required for the purpose of ensuring an efficient and effective team

Early Steps Credentialing Requirements:

- Resume
- Copy of Professional License
- Ability to confirm one year post graduation experience with children birth through four years old
- College Transcripts

Requires Ability to:

- Complete required local Early Steps training requirements
- Submit and adhere to Provider Agreement requirements per local, state & federal policy
- Pass Level II Background Screening
- Apply for Early Intervention and discipline-specific Medicaid numbers
- Enroll with Region B Managed Care Medicaid Plans
- Independently bill the local Early Steps office and Medicaid plans for services provided
- Travel between various locations
- Work independently as well as a team member
- Set up a home office and maintain supplies
- Independently manage and maintain caseload and schedule
- Submit documentation written in English
- Appropriately interact and communicate with individuals from various cultural & socio-economic backgrounds
